Grades of C- or higher are required for the mathematics and science courses as prerequisites. No Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory (S/U) grades will be accepted.

Courses 2 and 3 should be AS.210.251 Intermediate Italian I and AS.210.252 Intermediate Italian II.

Students who matriculated in Fall 2021 or earlier should complete a total of 12 credits of Advanced Labs, of which at least 6 credits must be in ECE and/or CS. Both EN.520.498 and EN.520.499 will count as ECE Advanced Labs for students matriculating in Fall 2021 or earlier.

Three courses (9 credits) must have the Science and Data foundational ability tag from approved departments; one must be at the 200-level or higher, two must be in the same department.*
